

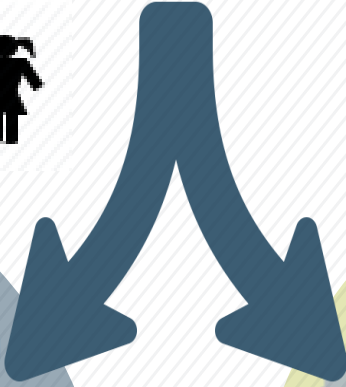
You may receive a scheduled visit from a community visitor or you can contact them for help or request a visit if you need to see them.

How OPG can help children & young people in the child protection system

Child advocates are lawyers who can help you express your views to adults, support you to resolve disputes and make sure your opinions are heard.

Your community visitor (CV)

- For help to resolve your questions and concerns
- For help accessing services
- To express your views to Child Safety
- To know your rights
- For help when transitioning out of care
- To make sure your needs are met where you live



An OPG child advocate legal officer (CA)

- For legal advice and information
- For access to legal assistance
- For support in meetings or in court
- To express your views to a judge or other adult
- To make a formal complaint
- To resolve issues or disputes
