

This book is from the Public Guardian of Queensland.



A **guardian** is someone who can help you make personal and health decisions.



This book is about who can help people in Queensland with decisions.





The **Public Guardian** can help with personal and health decisions if you have **no one** else.



We can help with things like

• where you live



• who you can have contact with



• what health care you get



• who can give you support services

• problems to do with the law.









We can also help decide if **restrictive practices** are right for you.



Restrictive practices is when someone limits what you can do, to keep you and others safe.



For example, someone might

• give you medicine to make you calm



• lock sharp knives in a drawer.

What we cannot help you with

The Public Guardian **cannot** help you with decisions about

money

• property.

The Public Guardian **cannot** help you manage your daily life.

For example

• we cannot be your carer

• we cannot take you to appointments

• we **cannot** help you move house.
















You can ask someone you trust to apply.



For example

• a family member




• a good friend.

The law says the Public Guardian **must** be your guardian if there is no one else.

Who can help you with money?



The **Public Trustee** can help manage your money if you have no one else to help.



The Public Trustee can manage things like

your pension






your bills



your bank account



how you spend your money.



The Public Trustee is **not** part of the Public Guardian.

Who can choose the person to help you?



The Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal or QCAT can choose who helps you if you have no one else.



QCAT helps people solve problems.



QCAT can say

• the Public Guardian must help you

or



the Public Trustee must help you

or





both must help you.











QCAT will say what decisions you must get help with.
